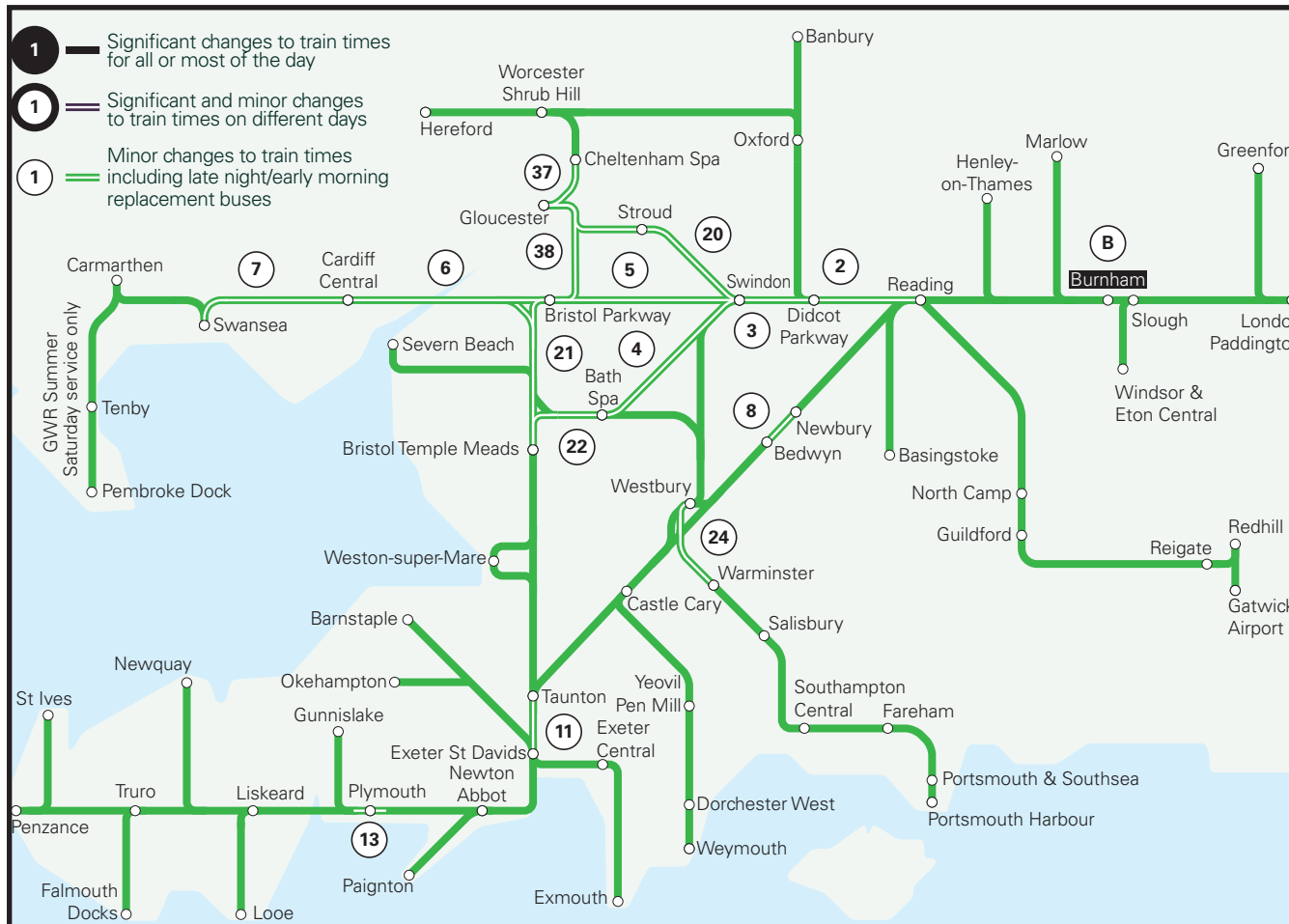

② ③ **Sunday** - The 2300 & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa, not calling at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Passengers for Didcot Parkway should use an alternative local service from Reading. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham.

⑦ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will run later from Bristol Parkway to Swansea.

⑥ **Saturday** - The 1923 Portsmouth Harbour to Cardiff Central will terminate at Newport. An alternative rail connection will be available from Newport to Cardiff Central.

⑧ **Monday to Thursday from approximately 2145 until end of service** - Buses will replace trains between Newbury and Bedwyn.

⑪ **Sunday** - The 2350 London Paddington to Penzance will arrive at Exeter St Davids later than usual. The 2115 Penzance to London Paddington will depart from Exeter St Davids slightly EARLIER than usual.

⑪ **Monday to Wednesday from approximately 2315 until end of service** - Late evening trains between Taunton, Tiverton Parkway and Exeter St Davids will be subject to retimings of up to 45 minutes.

⑬ **Saturday** - The 1640 Penzance to Cardiff Central will terminate at Plymouth. A connecting train will run from Plymouth to Cardiff Central.

⑳ ③⑦ **Sunday until approximately 1700** - Buses will replace trains between Stroud and Gloucester. Most trains between Swindon and Stroud will be retimed. Alternative rail connections will be available between Gloucester and Cheltenham Spa.

⑳ ③⑦ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2342 Swindon to Cheltenham Spa will depart EARLIER, and will be diverted to run non-stop from Swindon to, and terminate at, Gloucester. A replacement bus will serve intermediate stations via Stroud.

⑳ ②① **Sunday** - The 0938 Bristol Temple Meads to Worcester Shrub Hill will start from Bristol Parkway and will be diverted to run non-stop to Gloucester.

⑳ ②④ **Sunday** - The 2230 Cardiff Central to Warminster will terminate at Westbury. Passengers travelling to Dilton Marsh and Warminster should use an earlier service - the 2030 Cardiff Central to Portsmouth Harbour will call additionally at Dilton Marsh.

⑳ ③⑧ **Sunday until approximately 1700** - Buses will replace trains between Bristol Parkway and Gloucester. The first bus from Bristol Parkway to Gloucester will start back from Bristol Temple Meads.

⑳ ① **Saturday** - The 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington will not call at Burnham or Taplow. Replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.
