

Save up to 1/3 on most rail fares with a Devon & Cornwall Railcard

Who can buy one?

Anyone aged 16 years or over, who is a resident of the county of Devon, or Cornwall may apply.

How do I buy one?

The easiest way is at

GWR.com/DCRailcard

Alternatively complete the attached application form and take it, together with one document from the proof of residency list and one from the proof of identity list (see below) to any staffed station in Devon or Cornwall.

Are they transferable?

No. Devon & Cornwall Railcards are not transferable, and are for the sole use of the named holder and accompanying passengers.

Devon & Cornwall Gold Card

Residents of Devon and Cornwall, aged 16 or over, buying an Annual Season ticket for a journey wholly within Devon and Cornwall are issued with a Devon & Cornwall Gold Card.

This Gold Card gives the same benefits as a Devon & Cornwall Railcard, at no extra cost.

With a Gold Card, up to 4 children may travel with the card holder for any journey between the two specified stations, on the same Season Ticket, at a flat fare of £1 per child.

Which tickets do I receive discounts on?

- 1/3 off all Standard class Anytime or Off-Peak tickets for journeys not starting before 0845*, which are wholly within Devon and Cornwall
 - * It is also valid on the following trains:
 - On all services on the St Ives branch line
 - On all services between Exeter and Barnstaple, on a train going **to** Barnstaple
 - On all services between Exeter and Okehampton, on a train going to Okehampton.

- 0824 Plymouth to Gunnislake (any journey on this train)
- 0829 from Newton Abbot towards Penzance
- 0835 Barnstaple and 0843 Umberleigh towards Exeter
- 0838 from Newton Abbot towards Paignton
- 0843 from Liskeard towards Penzance
- 1/3 off a Cornwall or Devon Day Ranger
- 1/3 off Devon & Cornwall Rover
- 1/2 off St Ives Bay Line Day Ranger
- 1/3 off one accompanying adult ticket
- Up to 4 accompanying children, aged 5-15 on the day of travel, can travel for a flat fare of £1 each, or £2 each per day with a Rover ticket, or Day Ranger

 Discounted tickets can be used for travel on any national train operator that serve the stations shown on the map below

Discounts are **not** available on:

- Season tickets
- Advance tickets
- First Class tickets. You may upgrade a discounted standard ticket at the weekend, or Bank Holiday by paying the usual charge
- Tickets bought in conjunction with any other special promotion, unless advertised
- Special excursion trains
- Bus services in Devon and Cornwall
- Ride Cornwall (Combined bus and rail ticket)
- Journeys extending beyond Tiverton Parkway or Axminster, see map below
